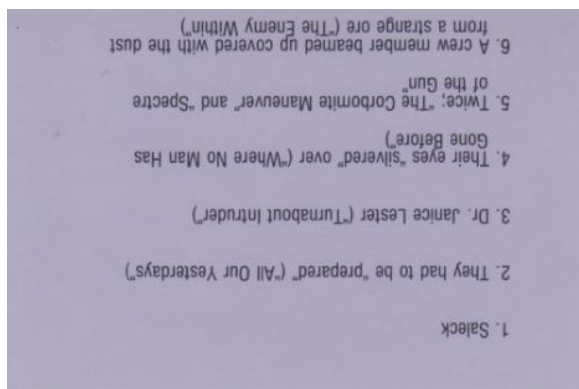


This is what an exploding star looks like (for real)

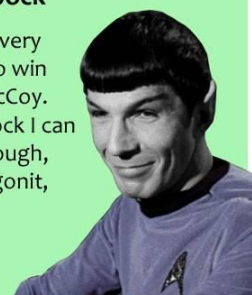

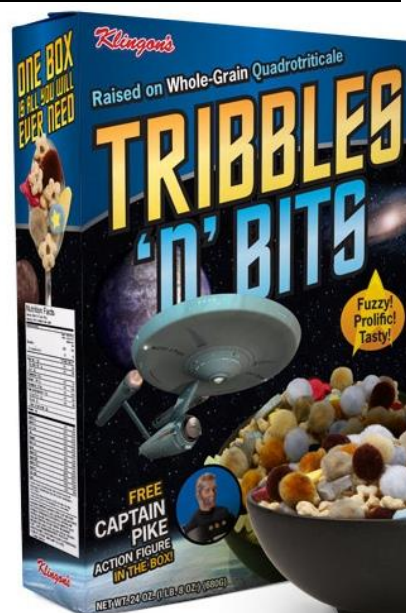

It was also FC Mark Williams birthday. We had a cake and a card for him.





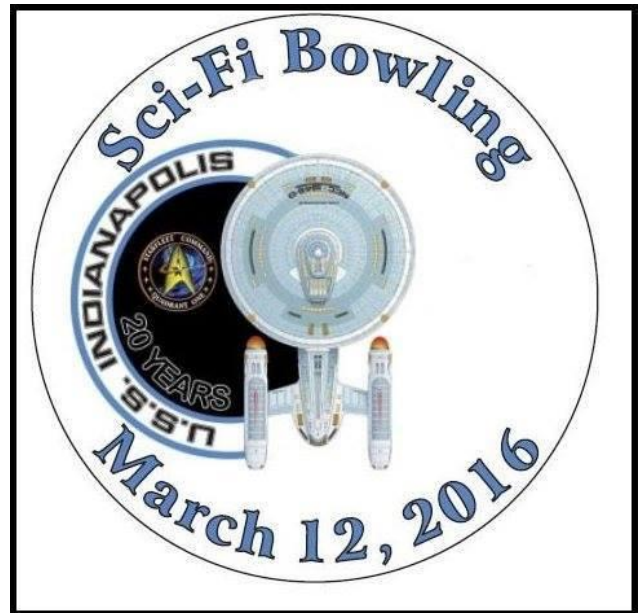
